FAQs

How much does it cost?

Recommended level of \$120 = \$12 per month for 10-month payroll.

Don't my dues already pay for this?

No – money to candidates is from PIE which is funded strictly by voluntary deduction.

Are my contributions tax deductible? See above – contributions are eligible for Oregon state tax credit of up to \$50 per individual return and \$100 per joint return.
