OEA RA

- OEA RA will be April 27-28, 2018 at Red Lion Jantzen Beach
- Membership information scheduled to be released by NEA on January 23
 - Credentials resolves duplicate memberships Friday, January 26
 - Delegate allocation cannot be determined until duplicate memberships are resolved
- Delegate allocation information will be sent via email no later than February 10, 2018
- Delegate names due to the Office of the OEA President by March 13, 2018
 - Delegate names received after March 13 will be 'late seated delegates' and will not be allowed onto the RA floor until the motion passes to seat late delegates; this motion takes place immediately after RA is called to order
- OEA RA Handbook:
 - Electronic copy scheduled to be available (sent via email, OEA RA page on OEA website) no later than March 9
 - Hard copies tentatively scheduled to be complete March 16; will be sent to OEA offices
- Communicate Pre-RA meeting (PRAM) information to all delegates (your Board Director can assist you with this)

OEA Elections

- Nominations for OEA Officers
 - Due to the Office of the OEA President by February 26, 2018
 - Elected at OEA RA on April 28, 2018
 - Nomination packets sent via email on November 2, 2017 and are available on the OEA website
 - Vacancies: Regional Vice Presidents (all Regions), Education Support Professional Director, NEA Director
- Nominations for OEA Board Directors
 - Deadline January 16, 2018
 - Elected by mail in ballot
 - Ballots will be sent no later than February 20 and must be received/postmarked by March 10
 - OEA Board Director ballots also include NEA RA State Delegate elections
 - 2018 Vacancies
 - 3-year Term: Districts 03b, 04, 05, 07, 10a, 14, 17, 18 and 26a
 - 1-year Term: District 06, 08, 12, 19, 20b

NEA RA

- 2018 NEA RA takes place in Minneapolis, MN
 - Travel dates: June 29 and July 6
- NEA to send emails to Local Presidents beginning the week of January 29 with delegate allocation information (*tentative date*)
 - All forms will be sent electronically via email; link will be provided to NEA website for forms & info
 - OEA will follow up with emails through the deadline of April 10
 - Locals eligible to cluster will receive separate emails including clustering details/instructions and list of locals eligible to cluster
- OEA begins sending emails to NEA RA delegates the week of April 10
- State delegates to the NEA RA
 - Nominations due January 16, 2018
 - Region I:** 6 positions, 3-year term **Region II:** 4 positions, 3-year term **Region III:** 3 positions, 3-year term
 - Elected by mail-in ballot; ballots will be sent no later than February 20 and must be received/postmarked by March 10
 - NEA RA State Delegate ballots also include OEA Board Director elections
 - Ballots will be counted by Credentials Committee March 24 and results will be shared on March 26
 - Locally elected delegate names due to the Office of the OEA President by April 10, 2018 – earlier is better so that we can send delegates information about First Caucus
 - First Caucus meeting will be April 29th at the Red Lion Janzen Beach
 - Travel allotment scheduled to be approved by OEA Board on January 20 (*details will be shared with all Local Presidents*)
