

2017 Taxes: Dues and PAC Contribution Deductions

Members can deduct 62% of union dues (NEA, OEA, and Local dues) on their federal taxes. (**Please Note:** This is a change from past tax years where 100% of dues were deductible). Please check your W-2 or your last pay stub to find your total union dues deducted for the 2017 calendar/tax year and then calculate 62% of that amount as your deduction. If neither your W-2 nor your last pay stub provides the data you need, please contact your district payroll office to obtain the total deducted for the year. If you have specific questions about tax deductions, please consult your tax specialist.

For OEA-PAC contributors (OEA's political action fund/ voluntary contributions, formerly OEA PIE) – that amount is eligible for a straight tax credit on state taxes and the limit is \$50 for single filing and \$100 for couples filing. OEA will send out a tax statement in January with the contribution amount. If you have contributed to OEA-PAC during the 2017 tax year and have not received your tax statement from OEA by February 10, 2018, please contact Jackie Judge at OEA HQ (Jackie.judge@oregoned.org).
