- Additional Planning Time
- Additional Classified Support
 - Extended Contract
- Additional Licensed Staff During Math/LA
 - Specialists Supporting Math/LA
- Observation of Other Split Teachers
 - Regrouping for Math/LA

Individual Support

Teacher Leader Support: Each grade level split will have a teacher leader or two (depending on the need) who has taught a grade level split with success and will be available for supports such as mentoring, planning questions, curriculum problem solving and observations. They will receive extended contract for the time they invest in supporting their colleagues and two hours of prep for classroom observations.
