The District and HEA use the cost savings from the low-cost plans to help create a Health Reimbursement Arrangement (HRA). The HRA supplements the two plans, providing a lower Deductible and Out of Pocket Maximum (MOP) and a MUCH better value to you! How Does It Work?

Through a simple claims process, you can experience the benefits of a lower In-Network Deductible and Max Out of Pocket by only paying the lower deductible and then 20% until you reach the lower max out of pocket.
